Takeaways

- As of 2021 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2016, growing by 14,013. Population is expected to increase by 1.0% between 2021 and 2026, adding 5,376.
- From 2016 to 2021, jobs increased by 2.4% in Stanislaus County, CA from 196,848 to 201,585. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 1.9% by 0.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.3% to 56.8% between 2016 and 2021.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.2% of Stanislaus County, CA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.3% below the national average), and **7.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.



Aug 2022 Labor Force Breakdown




Educational Attainment





Unemployment by Gender










Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

Stanislaus County, CA had an August 2022 unemployment rate of 5.17%, decreasing from 7.54% 5 years before.






Millennials

Stanislaus County, CA has 20,043 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 29,777.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 164,372 people 55 or older, while there are 135,975 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is high in Stanislaus County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 225,037 racially diverse people, while there are 342,106 here.




Property Crime


















