Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 3.2% since 2017, growing by 28,792. Population is expected to increase by 4.4% between 2022 and 2027, adding 40,394.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 6.8% in Kern County, CA from 356,327 to 380,413. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.8% by 3.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.4% to 59.9% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.5% of Kern County, CA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.3% below the national average), and **7.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Support Activities for Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity




Population Trends




Millennials

Kern County, CA has 202,881 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 186,277.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Kern County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 274,541 people 55 or older, while there are 200,942 here.




Racial Diversity

Kern County, CA has 6.81 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Growing Occupations




Occupation Jobs Growth

Top Occupation Employment Concentration






Top Posted Occupations
